Pre-entries for the ODE only, closing date Friday 2nd August 2019. Late entries may be accepted if space allows. This event is designed to encourage inexperienced pony/rider combinations.

ALL PONIES ATTENDING MUST HAVE BEEN VACCINATED AGAINST EQUINE FLU WITHIN THE LAST 12 MONTHS. PASSPORTS WILL BE CHECKED.

Mini One Day Event Dressage will not start before 9am.

Pre entries only - £30 per combination (£27 LHPC members) to include medical fee
Entry Form on reverse of schedule. Late entries £35 per combination.

This event will involve riding the **PC D Level (Walk & Trot) Dressage Test 2012** and jumping both a cross country and show jumping course. The dressage test may be called. For dressage test go to http://www.pcuk.org/index.php/disciplines/dressage/dressage_tests/ and click on "Other Dressage Tests".

Riders must wear a body protector for cross country. Pony Club Members must have hats tagged with official Pony Club aquamarine tag prior to the event. Dressage and Show jumping should be in jacket & tie. For XC Cross Country colours or PC sweatshirts to be worn. As this is a very novice event any normal riding bit and martingale can be used. A whip can be carried in all 3 phases (short whip for SJ and XC).

Class 1: PC D Level (Walk & Trot) Dressage Test 2012, 45cm show jumping and cross-country course. This class will be split into 3 sections; led, assisted and unassisted. This cross-country course will be within an enclosed and roped area. **NO SPURS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THIS CLASS.**

Class 2: PC D Level (Walk & Trot) Dressage Test 2012, maximum 60cm show jumping and cross-country courses. This class will be split into 2 sections; assisted and unassisted.

Course Walk from 4pm on Friday 9th August, gates will be locked at 8pm. The course will not be deemed to be complete until 9am on the day of the competition. **Although we encourage competitors to keep to their times given this event is designed to encourage novice riders there will be a degree of flexibility allowed for SJ and XC times.**

Rosettes: 1st – 6th in each class/section.

Best dressage in each section. Best Ledbury in each section.

Gymkhana

Commencing at 2pm. Rosettes 1st – 6th.

Each class comprises of 5 races - £10 per set of races or £2.50 per race.

The races are bending, sweet race, ride and run, walk and trot (for class 7 and 8 this will include canter), cup/potato race. Races may be varied at the discretion of the judge.

- Class 4** **4 years and under, to be led**
- Class 5** **6 years and under, to be led.**
- Class 6** **8 years and under, may be assisted.**
- Class 7** **10 years and under, un-led**
- Class 8** **14 years and under, un-led**

Fun Handy Pony:

Commencing at 1pm. Rosettes for every competitor who completes.
Entry £3 at the ringside.

Clear Round XC:

Commencing at 1pm. This is a flagged and numbered course in an enclosed arena. It is a separate course from the Mini ODE. Max

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Judge's decision is final.
2. All classes to be run under Pony Club rules.
3. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or the Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials and Stewards. **All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by the Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Ledbury Hunt Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their Insurance will not cover it.**
4. **Hats to PAS 015, AS/NZS 3838 1998 / 2003 or Snell E2001 with chinstrap fastened MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED. Pony Club Members must have hats tagged with official aquamarine Pony Club tag prior to the event.**
5. **BODY PROTECTORS MUST BE WORN FOR CROSS COUNTRY. Body protectors must meet BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label) or Beta 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label).**
6. Ages as at 1st January 2019.
7. Spurs are not allowed in Class 1.
8. All children competing in the ODE must have attained their 4th birthday by the 1st January 2019.
9. Horses and Ponies must be 4 years old and over.
10. The committee will not be responsible for any loss or injury to any person, property or animal howsoever caused.
11. Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the incident together with a deposit of £20 which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
12. No cantering allowed around showground, warming up should take place in the appropriate area.
13. Refunds will only be given up to the closing date Friday 2nd August 2019. Refunds will only be given after the closing date on receipt of a valid veterinary/doctor's certificate.
14. In the event of cancellations entries will be refunded minus £5 cancellation fee. Refunds will be processed onto the cards they were paid for on.
15. The committee reserves the right to cancel or alter any classes.
